DESCRIPTION: Since 2012, Sourcewell and AASA have joined forces to bring the Helping Kids Program, an urgent mini grant that is funded through a partnership with Sourcewell, on behalf of needy families. Funding may be used for students clothing, medical care, dental care, eyeglasses, prescriptions, hearing aids, food, shelter, supplies, fuel, emergency transportation, childcare, enrichment, and academic or life-enhancing opportunities that could not otherwise be provided.
