### VOLUNTARY GROUP TERM LIFE/AD&D

<b>Eligibility</b>	All Active Full Time Employees of a participating employer enrolled in the group medical plan electing to offer Voluntary coverage, who regularly work 17.5 hours per week, unless the school district has a four-day work week then 15 hours per week is required to be eligible for insurance. Refer to your Employer for your waiting period and eligibility date. (Excluding MTSBA)
<b>Group Term Life/AD&amp;D Benefit: Employee</b>	\$10,000 - \$500,000, in increments of \$10,000, not to exceed 4 times annual earnings.
<b>Guarantee Issue Amount – Employee</b>	\$100,000
<b>Group Term Life/AD&amp;D Benefit: Spouse</b> (Includes Domestic Partners)	\$5,000 or \$10,000
<b>Guarantee Issue Amount – Spouse</b>	\$10,000
<b>Group Term Life/AD&amp;D Benefit: Child(ren)</b>	Live Birth to Age 26 - \$5,000 or \$10,000
<b>Age Reduction Schedule</b>	Employee Voluntary Group Term Life/AD&D benefits reduce by 50% of the original amount at age 70. Benefits terminate at retirement unless Employee chooses Retiree option.  Spouse Voluntary Group Term Life/AD&D terminates at the employee’s retirement.
<b>Employee Contribution</b>	100%
<b>Waiver of Premium</b>	If an employee is unable to engage in any occupation as a result of injury or sickness for a minimum of 6 months, prior to age 60, premium will be waived for the employee’s life insurance benefit until the employee is no longer disabled or reaches age 65, whichever occurs first.
<b>Accelerated Death Benefit (ADB)</b>	Upon the employee’s request, this benefit pays a lump sum up to 75% of the employee’s Life insurance, if diagnosed with a terminal illness and has a life expectancy of 12 months or less. Minimum: \$7,500. Maximum: \$250,000. The amount of group term life insurance otherwise payable upon the employee’s death will be reduced by the ADB.
<b>Portability Feature</b>	Included
<b>Conversion Privilege (Life coverage)</b>	Included
<b>Exclusions</b>	One-year suicide exclusion applies to Supplemental Group Term Life coverage. AD&D exclusions are the same as Basic AD&D exclusions.

## GROUP ACCIDENTAL DEATH & DISMEMBERMENT (AD&D) PROGRAM SUMMARY

Group AD&D is an additional death benefit that pays in the event a covered employee dies or is dismembered in a covered accident. AD&D benefit is 24-hour coverage.

\* Loss must occur within 365 days of the accident.
